MEDIA STATEMENT- 28 February 2007

“RIDE FOR HOPE-BALEKELA ETHEMBENI”

The “Ride for Hope-Balekela Ethembeni” cycle tour started at the Pretoria Academic Hospital on 26 February 2007 and the cyclists have completed their route to Parys, Bothaville, Welkom, Brandfort and Bloemfontein on 28 February 2007. The team of fifteen are now heading for Gariep, Noupoot and Middelburg on 1 March 2007. According to tour organizer Roly von Gogh, who is also part of the team, “The weather conditions are extraordinarily high reaching 38 degrees and every team member are covering approximately 180km per day. A newcomer and sponsored development rider to the cycle team, Walter Segoe who has only been riding for two weeks before the tour started are amongst the strongest three in the team.” He added that in every community they have reached there were lots of questions and the cyclist drew alot of attention. The tour will end in Tygerberg Hospital on 9 March 2007.

This project is in partnership between CANSA, NTP Radioisotopes (Pty) Ltd and NTP’s parent organization, Necsa. Cancer is a non-profit organization whose aim is to substantially reduce the impact of cancer by promoting health in all communities within South Africa, through advocacy and the sustainable facilitation of research, prevention, early detection and care.

The main message that will be carried to South Africans directly or indirectly affected by cancer is that there is ever increasing **hope** of survival and cure and thanks due to the increased awareness and earlier detection and treatment of the disease.

A group of 15 cyclists comprised of NTP and Necsa personnel, cancer survivors and medical professionals will take to the long road over a period of 10-12 days covering approximately 1800km. This will mean riding an average distance of 180 km per day and maintaining an average speed of 25 km/hour! The group will be joined for short stretches by cyclists, including community leaders, celebrities, cancer sufferers and survivors, from towns through which the ride will pass. The cycle tour will include visits to centres en route where nuclear medicine is practiced and will incorporate daily awareness creation, educational, motivational and promotional activities focusing on nuclear medicine and cancer. The fundraising goal is to collect R 500

000.00 for CANSA (North West) to enable them to expand their Health promotion and education programmes in the Hartbeespoort-Brits area.

NTP Radioisotopes (Pty) Ltd, CANSA and Necsa have ploughed their full weight into this project and the success of this event will be determined by those cycling die-hards up for a challenge and also by your generous contributions.
