Necsa aims to be one of the most valuable national contributors towards alleviating the national shortage of skilled personnel in the science and engineering sectors. In addition, Necsa use the National Science Week to inform, educate and create awareness to the general public and learners about peaceful and medical uses of nuclear.

We have ‘edutainment” activities for learners as part of the programme that will be conducted throughout the week.
